*as Rosie*

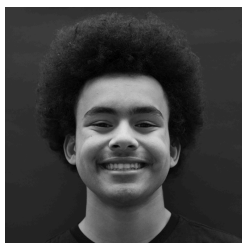

## Deirdre Marcella

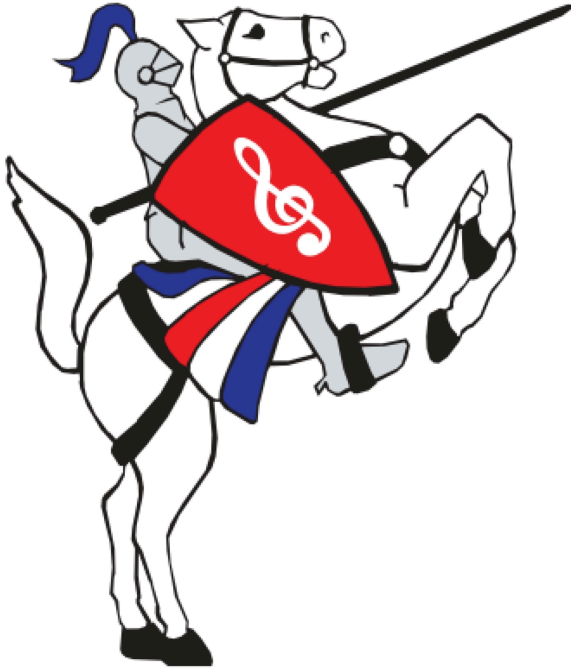
