---

## Artistic Directors: Ian O'Connor and Noah Payeur

Welcome to the Derry Opera House and welcome to the Londonderry High School Drama Club production of *Once Upon a Mattress*!

Fairytales often promise that "happily ever after" arrives neatly and predictably. *Once Upon a Mattress* allows our students to take the simplicity of happily ever after and analyze the nuances of life through the lens of castle walls and moats.

In this musical, the familiar story of *The Princess and the Pea* becomes a celebration of the unconventional—a reminder that authenticity, courage, and a little joyful chaos can upend even the most rigid expectations.

When we sat down to choose our show for this year, we wanted to choose something for our students that would take them outside of their comfort zones. *Mamma Mia* and *Footloose!* have one thing in common: music that transcends generations. *Once Upon a Mattress* has a beautiful score written by the daughter of famed musical theater composer Richard Rogers. Mary Rogers takes a classical story and propels it with wit and absurdity.

At its heart, this show asks a simple question: Who gets to decide what makes someone worthy? Queen Aggravain clings to rules and tests, convinced that control will keep her world safe. Princess Winnifred, by contrast, barrels into the kingdom with honesty, humor, and a refusal to shrink herself to fit anyone's idea of "delicate." The clash between these two forces is loud, funny, and delightfully absurd. It also reflects something real for our students.

As you watch Winnifred crash through expectations and rewrite the rules, I hope you are reminded that worthiness isn't measured by perfection, but instead by heart. Thank you for joining us, and please remember: A princess is a delicate thing.

*as Lady Beatrice*

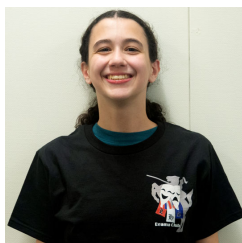

*Artistic Director*

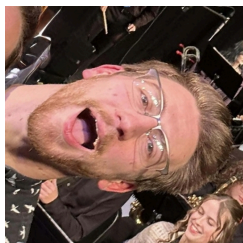

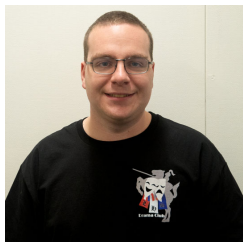
